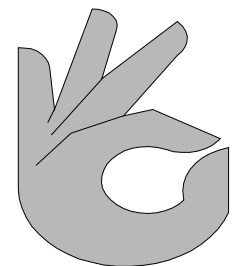
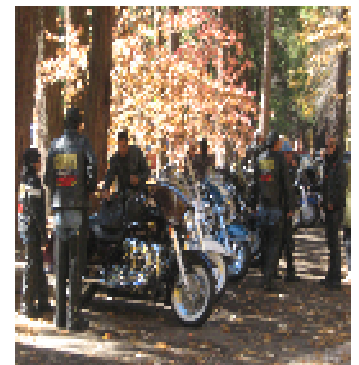
SOUTHEAST COASTAL

SOUTHEAST COASTAL

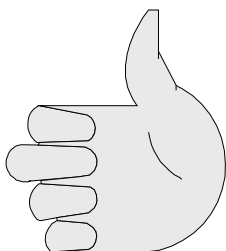

He was born with cerebral palsy and had always dreamed of riding a motorcycle. Someone built him his custom bike. Here is what he observed along his ride. His experience will inspire you.

I was going down the parkway and someone came up behind me on a crotch rocket. They popped a wheelie. I learned that others may go faster but we both eventually get there.

I learned to appreciate younger people and the skill and talent it takes to do things.

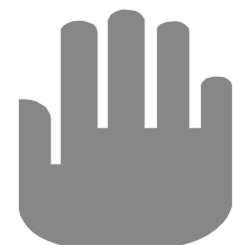
I learned that no matter how fast you go there is always somebody who wants to go faster and no matter how slowly you go somebody is always going slower. I learned not to be afraid to let others pass because they have their own ride. Their ride is not my ride.

I learned that like it or not I am bound by rules. I can follow but I am bound by certain laws that are in common to every rider and some that are specific for my ride. I must learn to ride and ride to learn.

I learned you can't judge people by what they look like or what they ride.

I learned dreams come true. Some may take a while but they will. They may not look exactly like what you dreamed but I learned to appreciate the good and not worry about the rest.

I learned that some will oppose your dream but there are also many who will rejoice with you. It may surprise you which one is which!
