Jesus said to her, “Give me a drink.” She replied, “Why would a Jewish man ask a Samaritan woman for a drink of water?” (For Jews have no dealings with the Samaritans.) Jesus replied, “If you only knew who I am and the gift that God wants to give you, you'd ask me for a drink, and I would give you living water.” The woman replied, “But sir, you don't even have a bucket, and the well is very deep. So where do you find this ‘living water’? Do you really think that you are greater than your ancestor Jacob who dug this well and drank from it himself, along with his children and livestock?” Jesus answered, “If you drink from Jacob's well, you'll be thirsty again, but if anyone drinks the living water I give them, they will never be thirsty again. For when you drink the water I give you, it becomes a gushing fountain of the Holy Spirit, flooding you with endless life!”

This water of the spirit is endless and brings us eternal life!

Brother Jerry's life here on earth may have ended but his anointing remains and will increase and thrive like never before on us all that will flow with it.

The spirit of increase by association, the spirit of favor and grace to run this race with vigor and passion like never before. More revelation brings more light and inspiration than ever before.
