Chariots of Light – Comrades in Christ (from Scott Kiekoover)

2 Thessalonians 1:3 – We are bound to thank God always for you, Brethren, as it is fitting, because your faith grows exceedingly, and the love of every one of you all abounds toward each other, 4 so that we ourselves boast of you among the churches of God...

"I tell the truth, I lie not, my conscience also bearing me witness in the Holy Spirit" (Romans 9:1), that Michelle and I have many times spoke to other pastors and ministerial organizations about the unique and uncommon unity that we have experienced with the brothers and sisters, the comrades, here in the Chariots of Light.

I don't use the words "unique and uncommon" as flattery. In Peter's second epistle he opens with "to those who have obtained like precious faith". A fellow minister (Keith Moore) once pointed out that "like precious" carries with it the idea of being rare, or uncommon. God has done a work in the Chariots of Light that has truly developed a unity of faith in which we have become "**Brethren**", brothers and sisters, comrades to the Glory of God.

2 Peter 1:1 ...to those who have obtained like precious faith with us...

Throughout Paul's writing in the New Testament, he uses the word "**brethren**" when writing to the churches. According to Rick Renner in his book *Sparkling Gems* the word brethren carries two meaning that I think illustrate the unity that we experience within the Chariots of Light.

The first meaning came from the medical world to describe two people who were born of the same womb. They used this word to convey the idea "You and I are brothers! We come out of the same womb of humanity, we have the same feelings, similar emotions, and we deal with the same issues in life. In every respect, we are truly brothers". In part Paul's thinking was that we are born from the same womb of God, related by the blood of Jesus Christ and members of the same spiritual family.

The word "**brethren**" also had another very significant meaning during New Testament times. It was used during the time of Alexander the Great to describe faithful soldiers. These fighting men and women were true brothers, **comrades** and partners who were united to fight the same fight, handle the same weapons and win the same wars.

2 Timothy 2:3 – Thou therefore endure hardness, as a good soldier of Jesus Christ.

Thus to be a "brother" meant that a person was a true comrade.

Throughout the thick and thin of battle, these soldiers stood together, achieving a special level of brotherhood known only by those who **stay united** together in the heart of the fray. This was also part of what Paul had in mind when he wrote to the early church.

As I was meditating on the love and the unity that God has developed in the Chariots of Light over the years, I thought this writing from Rick Renner was such a description of how I feel towards this ministry and the members.

From time to time, Alexander the Great would hold huge public ceremonies where he would give awards to soldiers who had gone the extra mile in battle. When the most coveted awards were given, Alexander the Great would beckon the most faithful soldiers on stage to stand next to him. Before an audience of adoring soldiers, Alexander would embrace each faithful soldier and publicly declare, "Alexander the Great is proud to be the brother of this soldier".

After serving at the side of fellow Chariots for many years now, I would like to declare before the body of Christ "**what an Honor it is to serve at your side and what a privilege and blessing to call you all my comrades in Christ**".

Let us not grow weary in well doing, let us stir each other on to good works and let us all continue to fight the good fight of faith for ourselves and for each other that the works of Jesus may carry on until His Blessed return.

I am convinced now more than ever that the anointing and the success of the Chariots of Light rest so much on the love and unity we possess. I think it is good and right to remind each other of this blessing that we have and to esteem it with great value. In all that we do and the conversations that we have and the thoughts we allow ourselves to think, we must guard the unity and love that we have for one another.

Ephesians 4:1 ...walk worthy of the calling with which you were called 2 with all lowliness and gentleness, with longsuffering, bearing with one another in love, endeavoring to keep the unity of the Spirit in the bond of peace.

Though there are differences for sure in our personalities and life experiences and other characteristics of our lives, there is a unity of **passion and purpose** that God Himself has imparted into each one of us by His precious Holy Spirit. As we have another wonderful year ahead of us, with great expectations of a greater Glory manifesting in our lives and in the ministry of the Chariots of Light, hold fast to this rare and priceless blessing and position in Christ that we have amongst each other.
