CHARIOTS OF LIGHT - PHILIPPIANS 2:15 – “SHINE AS LIGHTS”

John 15:7-10 TPT – “But if you live in life-union with me and if my words live powerfully within you –then you can ask whatever you desire and it will be done. When your lives bear abundant fruit, you demonstrate that you are my mature disciples who glorify my Father! “I love each of you with the same love that the Father loves me. You must continually let my love nourish your hearts. If you keep my commands, you will live in my love, just as I have kept my Father’s commands, for I continually live nourished and empowered by his love.”

To manifest more of God and to manifest more of who He is, we must nurture our hearts with who He is, and how He does it. So let’s go to where love is and to where love isn’t.

1 Corinthians 13:1-13 TPT – “If I were to speak with eloquence in earth’s many languages, and in the heavenly tongues of angels, yet I didn’t express myself with love, my words would be reduced to the hollow sound of nothing more than a clanging cymbal. And if I were to have the gift of prophecy with a profound understanding of God’s hidden secrets, and if I possessed unending supernatural knowledge, and if I had the greatest gift of faith that could move mountains, but have never learned to love, then I am nothing. And if I were to be so generous as to give away everything I owned to feed the poor, and to offer my body to be burned as a martyr, without the pure motive of love, I would gain nothing of value. Love is large and incredibly patient. Love is gentle and consistently kind to all. It refuses to be jealous when blessing comes to someone else.

Love does not brag about one's achievements nor inflate its own importance. Love does not traffic in shame and disrespect, nor selfishly seek its own honor. Love is not easily irritated or quick to take offense. Love joyfully celebrates honesty and finds no delight in what is wrong. Love is a safe place of shelter, for it never stops believing the best for others. Love never takes failure as defeat, for it never gives up. Love never stops loving. It extends beyond the gift of prophecy, which eventually fades away. It is more enduring than tongues, which will one day fall silent. Love remains long after words of knowledge are forgotten. Our present knowledge and our prophecies are but partial, but when love's perfection arrives, the partial will fade away. When I was a child, I spoke about childish matters, for I saw things like a child and reasoned like a child. But the day came when I matured, and I set aside my childish ways. For now we see but a faint reflection of riddles and mysteries as though reflected in a mirror, but one day we will see face-to-face. My understanding is incomplete now, but one day I will understand everything, just as everything about me has been fully understood. Until then, there are three things that remain: faith, hope, and love—yet love surpasses them all. So above all else, let love be the beautiful prize for which you run.”

We could stay in these verses for a long time but look again at the first verse. It says I can do all these things, but if I don't express it in love, it would be useless. Expression is big to God. The love expression will bring a manifestation of His kindness to you and through you for others.

If we give great prophetic words, and words of knowledge, and operate in the gift of faith to move any obstacle, and if it's not presented in love, it is useless and helpless. It actually means nothing unless our motive is always through love. If we gave away everything we had, for any other reason than the pure motive of love, it would not be valuable to God.

This is what LOVE IS and isn't and what we must be for others.

Love is the largest of all things.

Love is incredibly patient.

Love is gentle and constantly kind to everyone.

Love always shows honor and respect.

Love refuses to be jealous when blessings come to someone else.

Love does not brag about its own achievements, and self-importance.

Love does not participate in shame or disrespect of others.

Love does not quickly get irritated and take offense.

Love is joyful and glad when honesty wins but does not find delight in anything wrong.

Love is the safest place to live your life and always believes the best of others.

Love never takes failure as defeat because it never gives up knowing love never fails.

Love never stops loving, never!

Love causes every gift to work that God has given, but it goes far beyond any gift. It is the greatest gift.

Love will remain when all great words have been spoken, words of knowledge have been forgotten, but love will remain.

Love will remain when all great words have been spoken, words of knowledge have been forgotten, but love will remain. Everything that we have that is partial will come complete and whole, when love's perfection

arrives, we will become complete and mature sons of God. No more childish ways, no more childish thoughts, not incomplete, but we will be complete through the eternal glory of His love.

Let love be the beautiful prize for which we run. This is the race we run; the race to love. To be like Jesus, to act like Jesus, to do the works that Jesus did, and the greater things He said that we would do. The greater things are basically and profoundly to love.

John 13-34-35 TPT – “So I give you now a new commandment: Love each other just as much as I have loved you. For when you demonstrate the same love I have for you by loving one another, everyone will know that you’re my true followers.”

I believe we can do this. Because nothing is impossible with God and He is ever with us. So let’s purpose to walk/live in a greater level of love this year with ourselves and others.
